Welcome and Announcements:

Agenda and current calendar of events for 2009-2010 school year were passed out.

Minutes from July 14, 2009 were accepted as written.

Treasurer's Report:

Angela Kupiec reported that she got the June 30, 2009 audit report back and everything was approved. She presented the financial statements for the period from July 1, 2009 to September 8, 2009. They were accepted as presented. PTA budget for the 2009-2010 year was presented. Starr Scano made a motion to approve the budget, and Sue Disney seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous, in favor.

Fall Festival:

Jennifer Bowers and Christine Freeze gave a report on the status of the Fall Festival which will be held October 23 (has now been changed to October 29) from 5:30 to 8:30 p.m. It was noted that we won't be preselling meals this year. We'll be selling individual tickets for \$1 and wristbands for \$10 (in advance) and \$15 (at the door). Individual tickets will be for food. We're still waiting on the prices for the food. Food will include Hot dogs, pizza, corndogs, nachos, popcorn, and cotton candy. Everything will be one or two tickets. The wrist bands cover all the games. There will be an auction for baskets. Members were asked to think of businesses that might donate items to the school. Kristy is in charge of volunteers.

"Fun" Classes:

Jill Marker gave an update on fun classes. We are trying to bring back the Drama class and Ms. Mini's Writing class. Other programs are being explored: Spanish, Math Monkey, Chess, and Pastry Chef Classes.
